- 2 Place a tick in the circle next to the names of the candidates for whom you wish to vote.
- 3 You may vote for a **maximum** of FOUR (4) candidates. You may vote for less than four candidates if you wish.
- 4 After voting carefully detach the voting paper along the indicated perforation and place the bottom portion in the enclosed freepost envelope and post it to the Returning Officer.
- 5 Postal voting closes at **12 noon on Thursday 15 September 2016**. A postal vote will still be counted if received after the closing date provided that the envelope is postmarked 15 September 2016 or earlier and received within 3 working days of the closing date.
- 6 If you spoil or destroy the voting paper, call the **Election Helpline** on **0800 666 047** to receive a replacement paper.
