TERTIARY EDUCATION GRANT

POLICY

The following criteria apply to all applications for grants/scholarships for secondary education:

- 1. Applications must be received before 17th March 2017, 5.00pm.
- 2. All applications must be completed on the official Ngāti Pāhauwera Manaaki Committee (NPMC) application forms.
- 3. All applications must be completed in full for further consideration.
- 4. Grants are available ONLY to registered Ngāti Pāhauwera (NP) members who are resident in Aotearoa and who are studying at a tertiary education institution in Aotearoa. Grants are available for full-time and part-time study.
- 5. Grants will be given to applicants who meet the following criteria:
 - a. Applicants must be a registered beneficiary of Ngāti Pāhauwera; and
 - b. Applicants must be studying at a tertiary institution which is defined as study at any approved and recognised tertiary institution within New Zealand.
- 6. PRIORITY will also be given to those students applying in the following areas of study:
 - a. Matauranga Maori/Te Reo
 - h. Sciences
 - c. Business Management
 - d. Early Childhood Education/Teaching
 - e. Engineering
 - f. Medicine/Surgery/Nursing Forestry
 - g. Forestry
 - h. Farming
 - i. Horticulture

Consideration will be given to all other tertiary programme applications also.

- 7. The tenure of the grant is one year. Applicants must submit a new application each year.
- 8. Grants will contribute towards TUITION FEES ONLY. Applicants must provide certified evidence of their:
 - Year of study (e.g year 1 of one year certificate, year 1 of two year diploma, year 1 of three year degree);
 - NZQA/NCEA Level Qualification;





NAME OF THE PARTY OF THE PARTY

(e.g. level 4 – first year of certificate, level 5 – first year of degree, level 8 post graduate diploma, level 9 – masters);

- Official confirmation of enrolment (interim or conditional enrolments will not be considered);
- Official name of qualification;
- List of courses/subjects;
- Status of study (e.g. full-time, or part-time);
- Course start date; and
- Course finish date;
- Course invoice (stating tuition component of fees).

The above information must be on the Learning Institutions Official letterhead.

- 9. Grants in consecutive years will depend on academic record. Applicants must pass a minimum of 75% of courses to be eligible for further grants. Evidence to be provided.
- 10. A personal statement is reuired to support every application. Applicants must provide a minimum of 100 words outlining their current involvement with their Ngāti Pāhauwera Marae/Iwi OR their intended contribution to their Ngāti Pāhauwera Marae/Iwi future.
- 11. If an applicant withdraws from their course prior to receiving funding, they must notify NPMC. If this does not occur, an applicant may not be eligible for further grants.
- 12. NPMC may require successful applicants to participate in iwi activities as a condition of the grant. Notification of any requirement will be provided to successful applicants. NPMC reserves the right to use a successful applicants name and other details for publicity and promotion purposes.
- NPMC has the sole discretion to accept or decline any application. Further
 correspondence in relation to the decline or acceptance of applications will not be
 entered into.
