## **TERTIARY EDUCATION GRANT**

## Te Oranganui o Ngāti Pāhauwera

A Supportive, Healthy, Vibrant, Prosperous and United Ngāti Pāhauwera

### **POLICY**

The following criteria apply to all applications for grants for education tertiary school boarding applications:

- 1. Applications must be received before the **Sunday 19 March 2023**.
- 2. All applications must be completed on the official Ngāti Pāhauwera Manaaki Committee (NPMC) application forms.
- 3. All applications must be completed in full for further consideration.
- 4. Grants are available ONLY to registered iwi members who are resident in Aotearoa New Zealand and who are studying at a tertiary education institution in Aotearoa.
- 5. Grants are available for established groups and must be for the benefit of beneficiaries of Ngāti Pāhauwera (NP).
- 6. Only applications from learners who meet the following criteria will be considered:
  - I. Applicant must be a registered beneficiary of Ngāti Pāhauwera.
  - II. Applicants must be studying and boarding at tertiary level which is defined as study at any approved and recognised tertiary institution within New Zealand.
- 7. The tenure of the grant is one year. Applicants must submit a new application each year.
- 8. PRIORITY will also be given to those students applying in the following areas of study:
  - I. Matauranga Maori/Te Reo
  - II. Sciences
  - III. Business Management
  - IV. Teaching
  - V. Engineering
  - VI. Medicine/Surgery/Nursing Forestry
  - VII. Forestry
  - VIII. Agriculture
  - IX. Horticulture
  - X. Information Technology

Consideration will be given to all other tertiary programme applications also.

9. The tenure of the grant is one year. Applicants must submit a new application each

year.

- 10. Grants will contribute towards TUITION FEES ONLY. Applicants must provide certified evidence of their:
  - Year of study (e.g year 1 of one-year certificate, year 1 of two-year diploma, year 1 of three-year degree);
  - II. NZQA/NCEA Level Qualification;
     (e.g. level 4 first year of certificate, level 5 first year of degree, level 8
     post graduate diploma, level 9 masters);
  - III. Official confirmation of enrolment (interim or conditional enrolments will not be considered);
  - IV. Official name of qualification;
  - V. List of courses/subjects;
  - VI. Status of study (e.g. full-time, or part-time);
  - VII. Course start date; and
  - VIII. Course finish date;
  - IX. Course invoice (stating tuition component of fees).

The above information must be on the Learning Institutions Official letterhead.

- 9. Grants in consecutive years will depend on academic record. Applicants must pass a minimum of 75% of courses to be eligible for further grants. Evidence to be provided.
- 11. A personal statement is required to support every application. Applicants must provide a minimum of 100 words outlining their current involvement with their NP Marae/Iwi OR their intended contribution to their NP Marae/Iwi future. Personal statements can be attached to this form or written in the spaces provided.
- 12. If an applicant withdraws from their tertiary institution prior to receiving funding, they must notify NPMC. If this does not occur, an applicant may not be eligible for further grants.
- 13. NPMC may require successful applicants to participate in iwi activities as a condition of the grant. Notification of any requirement will be provided to successful applicants. NPMC reserves the right to use a successful applicant's name and other details for publicity and promotion purposes.
- 14. NPMC has the sole discretion to accept or decline any application. Further correspondence in relation to the decline or acceptance of applications will not be entered into.
